Educational items for students to own (Book Pack through KAKA KIDS)

Attached is a list of items included in the book packs that the school recommends you purchase from KAKA Kids for your child to individually own and use. Please follow the instructions on the attachment to purchase the book packs **directly** from KAKA Kids.

All individual packs will be clearly named and delivered to the student's classroom and available for collection from your child's teacher at your Meet the Teacher appointment on Wednesday 28th January in Term 1. Orders must be placed by Friday the 12th of December to avoid a late surcharge of \$14.95 and ensure it is delivered to the school for the beginning of 2026.

Curriculum Consumables & Other Contributions (Please note; this amount is heavily subsidised by Gilgai Plains Primary School. Parents are asked to contribute a small percentage of the total cost)

These include resources for Maths (PRIME) and PRIME assessment platform, Essential Assessment platform, DIBELS assessment platform, Resilience Project Program, AUSLAN online platform, Time Table Rock Stars subscription, Decodable Readers Australia subscription, Novels to be studied, and Specialist programs.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities (provided on a user pays basis)

Gilgai Plains Primary School offers a range of optional items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides to deliver the Curriculum. The cost of extra-curricular items and activities (excursions, incursions etc) will be advised and invoiced throughout the year.

Kaka Kids Student Book Pack Ordering Instructions

Paid directly to KAKA Kids by following the ordering instructions:

1. Visit: www.gppsbt.sshop
2. Go to: PURCHASE BOOKLISTS in menu heading
3. Enter: GP8779 in the Guest Area
4. Select the pack(s) you require for the 2026 School year
5. Enter the student's name and then add pack to the cart.
6. Proceed to checkout and complete personal and payment details
7. An order confirmation will be sent to your email address

When placing an order for your child through the KaKa Kids website, you are required to put in their Compass Student ID. You can find this code by clicking on your child's profile, and listed in their personal information will be their Student ID. This Student ID will be 2 letters and 4 numbers, for example: ABC0001.

Refunds

Parent requests for refunds are subject to the discretion of the school and made on a case by case basis. Refunds will be provided where the school deems it is reasonable and fair to do so, taking into consideration whether a cost has been incurred, the Department's Parent Payment Policy and Guidance, Financial Help for Families Policy and any other relevant information. ONE PAGE OVERVIEW



FREE INSTRUCTION

Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the requirements of the Curriculum. This includes the Victorian Curriculum F-10, the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) and the Victorian Pathways Certificate.

Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.



PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:

Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non- curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.

Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
